HOW DO I START RECYCLING?

Recycling is easy...

First, set up a recycling corner in your home. Start by placing a recycling receptacle (bin, any container or bag) next to your trash bin so that you can separate recyclables from general waste.

RECEIPTS

There are different types (e.g paper and thermal receipts) but all are ok for the blue bins!



DRINK CARTONS (TETRA PAK)

They may have a waterproof lining, but it's ok to recycle them after washing!

Not practical to recycle as it is very difficult to separate the non-paper layer.

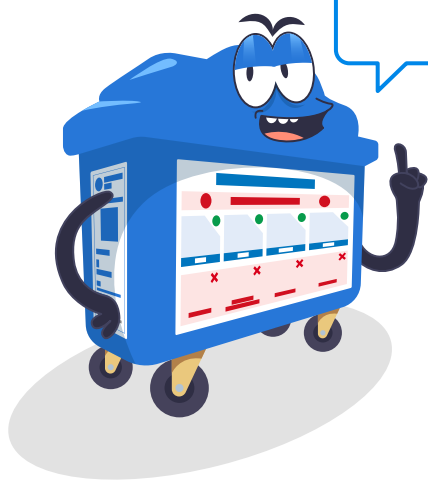

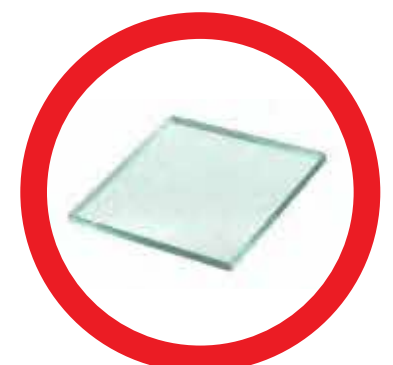

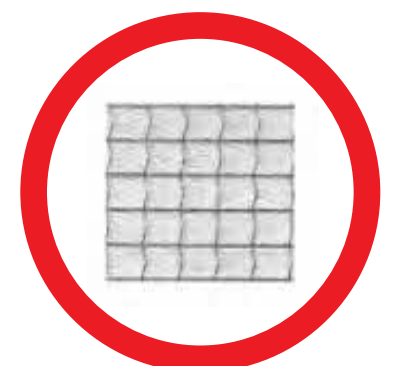

RUSTY METAL CANS

A small amount of rust is ok, but dispose them as waste if they look like this!



DIRTY ALUMINIUM FOIL & TRAYS

While aluminium can be recycled, they are often contaminated with food.



E-WASTE

Do not place them in the blue bins! Cables and laptops can be placed in e-waste bins. Recycle at specific e-waste collection points which can be found on [here](#).

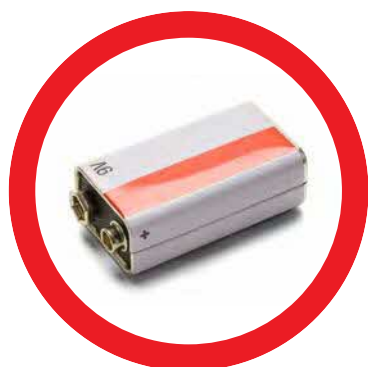

Deposit electronic waste in the e-waste bins situated at most shopping malls, community centres, supermarkets and retail outlets.



**POWER BANKS &
RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES**

Do remember to tape the ends of the batteries* and seal leaking batteries in a leak-proof container or bag first to prevent short-circuit or fire incidents. These items should be deposited in the e-waste bins.
